HAUMĀNA CAMPUS PARKING INFORMATION

Driving to school and parking on campus is a privilege. To earn this privilege, haumāna must have a valid driver's license and apply for and receive a KS Haumāna Parking decal. Parking is restricted to designated parking areas on campus and limited to 110 student parking stalls. Haumāna drivers are responsible for knowing and adhering to the rules and regulations for driving and parking on campus. Driving privileges may be suspended or revoked should haumāna fail to meet driving expectations. If this occurs, the student will be placed on the bottom of the waitlist and reissued a new permit, should a stall become available.

Approved haumāna drivers will receive a BLUE KSM Haumāna Parking decal with an assigned tag number. The decal will be placed inside the front windshield on the lower left corner of the driver's side, above any metal sun strip or visor tints.



All previously registered haumāna drivers do not need to reapply for a new parking pass. If haumāna are driving a different vehicle or vehicle information has changed, please resubmit an application with the new information. Students may register a maximum of two vehicles and both vehicles will have the same numbered parking decal. New drivers should complete the Haumāna Campus Parking Application and submit the completed form to the high school office to receive a parking decal *BEFORE* driving to campus. All drivers are required to attend a meeting to review campus driving & parking expectations, these will be schedule and communicated by Māhele Luna admin.

HAUMĀNA DRIVING & PARKING RULES & REGULATIONS

In accepting the privileges of driving and parking on Kamehameha Schools Maui Campus, I agree to abide by the following rules and regulations:

- I will only park the registered vehicle(s) in the designated haumāna parking zone (Pauahilani parking lot). Parental excuses are not accepted for parking in other areas on campus. Parking in other areas (staff parking lot, gravel, or grass lots, etc.) without administrative approval, will result in a suspension of my driving privilege for a minimum of two weeks. Parking in a marked Handicap stall without proper placard will result is loss of driving privilege and may also result in a citation from Maui Police Department. <u>Unauthorized, unknown, or unregistered vehicles may be subject to being towed off campus at the owner's expenses</u>.
- 2. I understand that students do not have self-assigned stalls nor can I claim or "kapu" an individual stall.
- 3. Park within the lines and occupy only ONE stall.
- 4. I understand I need to **arrive on campus by 7:53 am** to be at my first class by 8 am. I understand at the beginning of each week, we will begin our school oli at 8 am.
- 5. I understand that **3 unexcused tardies to school** will result in a suspension of my driving privilege for a minimum of one week. **Upon my 5th unexcused tardy**, my driving privileges will be revoked and I will be placed at the bottom of the waitlist. I understand that traffic or dropping off a younger sibling is not an acceptable excuse and will not be counted as an excused tardy.
- 6. My assigned parking decal must be placed on the front windshield on the lower left corner of the driver's side. The pass should be placed above any metalized sun strip or tint. The decal needs to be clearly visible from the outside at all times while the vehicle is on campus. If I lose my decal or my vehicle has changed, I must request a temporary pass at High School office.
- 7. I will not loan my vehicle or parking decal to another haumāna at any time. <u>I understand that if I lend my</u> parking decal to another haumāna, I will lose my driving privilege for up to 12 months.
- 8. I understand that driving on campus during the school day (8:00 am 2:35 pm), including driving to and from assemblies, large group meetings, etc, is not allowed and may result in the loss of my driving and parking privileges.
- 9. I understand loitering is not permitted in any parking lot, at any time.
- 10. I understand that all parking lots are off-limits during school hours. If I need to go to my car during the school day, I will get permission from the office (not teacher) BEFORE going to my car.
- 11. I will obey all posted speed limits and regulatory signs on campus and always yield the right of way to pedestrians. Running stop signs, speeding, or otherwise operating my vehicle in a reckless fashion will result in the loss of my driving and parking privileges on campus. Consequences will be progressive. 1st offense = 1 week suspension, 2nd offense = 9 weeks &/or bottom waitlist.
- 12. I will immediately report any tampering, loss or damage to my vehicle that occurs on this campus to the Safety & Operations Department at (808) 572-3122.
- 13. I will submit to a search of my vehicle at any time upon the request of the proper authorities, if I choose not to, I will lose my driving privilege.
- 14. I understand that the responsibility for a privately owned vehicle parked on campus lies with the individual driver/owner. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL THE SCHOOL REIMBURSE THE OWNER FOR THE COST OF REPAIR FOR VANDALISM OR THEFT.
- 15. I understand that transporting passengers in the bed of a pick-up truck or in the trunk of my vehicle will result in the loss of my driving and parking privileges on campus for 12 months.
- 16. I understand that motorcycles and mopeds driven by haumāna are not allowed on campus at any time.
- 17. I understand that my driving record will be considered when applying to park on campus for the current and follow school year.
- 18. I understand that it is my kuleana to read and comply with all regulations set forth on this application.
